MESSAGE FROM THE YOUTH CHAPLAIN

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.



As we enter the blessed month of October, I am reminded of a beautiful truth spoken by St. John Chrysostom, one of the early Fathers of the Church: "The

family is a little church, a place where the work of God begins." This statement captures the essence of what the Christian family is meant to be—a sanctuary where love, prayer, and faithfulness flourish. The Bible emphasizes this in Ephesians 5:25, where the relationship of husband and wife is likened to the love Christ has for the Church. The family, in this sense, becomes a living testament of God's grace, a place where faith is passed down from generation to generation.

In the Eastern liturgical tradition, the family is called the "domestic church," a sacred place where Christ's presence is felt daily. Through shared prayer, participation in the sacraments, and the love between parents and children, the family becomes a reflection of the Holy Trinity's unity and love. When we consider Family as a "domestic church," meaning it is a microcosm of the larger church where the spiritual life is nurtured. The family is seen as a place where Christ's love, grace, and salvation are lived out daily.

1. Sacramental Understanding: In the Eastern tradition, marriage is considered a sacrament, reflecting the union of Christ and His Church. Through marriage, the family becomes a holy space, where the couple is sanctified and called to live in love, faithfulness, and mutual support. The prayers during the marriage ceremony often emphasize the grace that sustains a family in unity.

2. Liturgical Participation: Families are encouraged to participate in liturgical life together, attending the Divine Liturgy and other services, receiving the sacraments, and practicing the rhythm of fasting, feasting, and prayer at home. This shared spiritual practice binds the family together and strengthens their faith.

3. Theological Foundation: The Eastern liturgical tradition often refers to the Holy Trinity as a model for the family. Just as the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are in perfect communion, families are called to live in harmony, love, and cooperation, reflecting the divine relationship in their daily lives.

This understanding places great emphasis on the family as a unit of spiritual growth and a reflection of God's kingdom on earth. A famous quote about the Christian family is from Pope John Paul II:

"As the family goes, so goes the nation and so goes the whole world in which we live." This highlights the central role of the family in shaping society and living out Christian values. This profound understanding of the family as a holy community is something we celebrate in our Parish, particularly during this month.

October is a month that brings us together as one family of faith, celebrating our shared heritage and renewing our commitment to Christian fellowship. It is with great joy that I share with you the various events planned for this special month, as we focus on our families, youth and edavaka Mission nurturing the spiritual life within our community.

Ohana Family Week (Oct 20-27): Our Parish will be celebrating Family Week, which will include the Kudumbakoottam family get-togethers, a time for three families to gather for meditation and prayer. This will be a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the significance of the family as a domestic church, strengthening bonds through shared faith.

Couples Meet: On 26th October, we will have a special gathering for couples, where we will explore how our marriages can be a reflection of Christ's love for the Church, fostering deeper connection and mutual growth in faith.

Parish Convention: From 22nd to 24th October, we are blessed to have a three-day Parish convention led by Mrs. Preena Mathew Kochamma. This will be a time of spiritual renewal for all, as we gather to hear the Word of God and recommit ourselves to the mission of the Church.

Youth Week: Our youth will take center stage this month, with both the Yuvajana Sakhyam and Youth Fellowship hosting various events. On 20th October, we will have a special Praise and Worship session led by Eugene Immanuel, under the auspices of the Youth Fellowship. Let us all join together to support and encourage our young people in their journey of faith.

Onam Celebration – Swararagam: On 6th October, the Yuvajana Sakhyam will host the Swararagam Onam celebration, a cultural and spiritual event filled with joy and fellowship. This will be a time of thanksgiving for the abundance of blessings we receive as a community.

I encourage each one of you to participate wholeheartedly in these events, allowing God to work through our gatherings to enrich our faith, deepen our relationships, and strengthen our resolve to live as faithful witnesses of Christ in the world.
