MESSAGE FROM YOUTH CHAPLAIN

Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings in the matchless name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

As we enter the month of July, I take this opportunity to reflect on the beauty and significance of our parish community. The word parish is deeply rooted in Christian tradition, both biblically and historically. The term derives from the Greek word "paroikia", meaning "sojourning" or "dwelling alongside." In the Old Testament, we see God's people as a pilgrim community—Abraham journeying in faith (Genesis 12), the Israelites in the wilderness (Exodus 13), and the exiles longing for restoration (Psalm 137). In the New Testament, 1 Peter 2:11 refers to believers as "foreigners and exiles," highlighting the temporary nature of our earthly dwelling and our identity as a holy community set apart for God. Over the centuries, the term parish developed in the early church to describe a localized body of believers within a geographical region, guided by pastoral leadership, sharing in Word, Sacrament, and community life. The parish is not merely a building or institution; it is a living fellowship of faith, love, and service.

Today, more than ever, the relevance of a parish lies in its ability to be a spiritual home—a space where faith is nurtured, hope is restored, and love is lived out. In a fast-paced and fragmented world, our parish is called to be a place of rootedness, discipleship, and mission. It is a training ground where generations come together in worship, fellowship, and service. Our parish is not just a structure; it is a story—formed by God's grace, shaped by the faith of our ancestors, and sustained by the active participation of every member. Its mission continues in the form of care for the poor, the nurturing of children and youth, standing for justice, and being a light in the local community.

This year, the Church is observing a 'liturgical year' of reflection, calling us to rediscover the richness and relevance of liturgy in our spiritual journey. Liturgy is not a repetition of rituals; it is the rhythm of divine encounter. It shapes our belief, forms our character, and unites us with the Body of Christ across generations. As a parish, let us take this season as an opportunity to teach and instil in our younger generation the depth and beauty of our liturgical life-reminding them that worship is not only for the sanctuary but for every sphere of life. The Eastern liturgical tradition is a rich and ancient stream of Christian worship that emphasizes **mystery, continuity, and community**. Among its many expressions, the **Antiochene tradition** holds a special place, especially for the churches of the Syriac heritage, including our own Mar Thoma Church. Rooted in the ancient city of Antioch, where the followers of Jesus were first called Christians (Acts 11:26), this tradition connects us to the early Church's worship, theology, and ecclesial life.

The **Antiochene liturgy** is characterized by a profound sense of reverence, theological depth, and scriptural richness. The prayers, responses, and liturgical acts are not merely ritualistic; they are deeply **biblical and symbolic**, inviting the worshipper into a spiritual participation in the life, death, and resurrection of Christ. One of the central emphases of this tradition is that worship is not just about God—it is an encounter with God, especially through the **Holy Qurbana**, which celebrates the presence of Christ in the midst of the worshipping community.

Another unique aspect of the Antiochene tradition is its use of **poetic and dramatic language**, including antiphonal singing (prayers exchanged between priest and people), symbolic

gestures, and a theology that affirms the sanctification of time and space through worship. The liturgy is not an isolated event; it is a cosmic act, where heaven and earth are joined in praise. This shapes a holistic spirituality—where believers carry the experience of the altar into everyday life, living as witnesses to the Kingdom of God. In today's world, returning to our liturgical roots can provide much-needed **spiritual grounding**.

In a culture of distraction and consumerism, the Antiochene tradition calls us back to **awe**, **attentiveness**, **and community-centered faith**. It teaches us that worship is not entertainment, but formation; not individualistic, but communal; not temporary, but eternal. When we gather for liturgy, we stand in continuity with the saints, martyrs, and generations who have gone before us, worshipping the same Lord with the same ancient faith.



മലങ്കരയുടെ അപ്പോസ്തലനായ തോമശ്ലീഹാ AD 52-ൽ കേരളത്തിൽ എത്തുകയുണ്ടായി തോമസ് എന്ന പേര് അരാമ്യ ഭാഷയിലെ "തോയോമാ" എന്ന പദത്തിൽ നിന്ന് രൂചപ്പെടുന്നത്. ഈ പദത്തിന് "ഇരട്ട" എന്നാണ് അർത്ഥം വിശുദ്ധ യോഹന്നാന്റെ സുവിശേഷത്തിൽ തോമസ് അപ്പോസ്തോലിന് ദ്വിദ്വിമോസ് എന്ന മറ്റൊരു പേരും ഉണ്ടായിരുന്നതായി കാണാം (John 11: 16) തോമസ് ഗലീലയിൽ നിന്ന് ഉളളവനാണ് എന്നാണ് അനുമാനം. "എന്റെ കർത്താവും എന്റെ ദൈവദേ" എന്ന് ഉത്മിതനായ യേശുവിനെ കണ്ടതായ അവസരത്തിൽ വിശ്വാസം പ്രാപിച്ച തോമസ് അപ്പോസ്തലൻ സുവിശേഷം ആയി മലങ്കരയിലേക് വരുകയും തുടർന്ന് മലങ്കരയിൽ ക്രിസ്തു സഭ വളരുകയും ചെയ്തു. തുടർന്ന് കൊടുങ്ങല്ലൂർ. പാലയൂർ പാലയാർ കോക്ക മംഗലം, പറവൂർ, നിരണം, കൊല്ലം, നിലയ്ക്കൽ, തിരുവിതാംകോട് എന്നിവിടങ്ങളിലായി ദേവാ ലയങ്ങൾ സ്ഥാപിതമായി. സെന്റ് തോമസ് ക്രിസ്തൻസ് തോമസ് ശ്ലീഹാ സുവിശേഷം അറിയിച്ചതുമൂലം ക്രിസ്തുവിൽ ആയവർ ആണ്. അതുകൊണ്ടാണ് സഭ അപ്പോസ്തലിക പിന്തുടർച്ചയുള്ള സഭ എന്ന് വിശേഷികിക്കുന്നത്.

സമർപ്പിച്ചതു മൂലം ചെന്നൈയിലെ മൈലാപൂരിൽ വച്ച് അപ്പോസ്തലന് രക്തസാക്ഷിത്വം കൈവരിക്കേണ്ടതായിവന്നു. ആഗോള ക്രൈസ്തവ ലോകത്തിൽ സെന്റ് തോമസിന്റെ നാമധേയത്തിൽ അറിയപ്പെടുന്ന ഒരേ ഒരു സയോണ് "മലങ്കര മാർത്തോമ്മാ സുറിയാനി സദ". സെന്റ് തോമസ് ദിനത്തിൽ ക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ സത്യന്വേഷികളായി ഈ ലോകത്തിൽ ജ്യോതി സ്റ്റുകളെ പോലെ പ്രകാശിക്കാനും, ക്രിസ്തുവിനായി മരണം കൈവരിക്കാനും, നമ്മുടെ ജീവിതത്തെ ദൈവകരങ്ങളിൽ സമർഷിക്കാം.
